We marked out the water lines for McDonalds, and repaired their stand so when they are ready to start work we can turn the water off in case of an emergency.

We dug up a water main shutoff on lower Main St. to investigate where it went, we discovered that it went nowhere but valve needs to be repaired.

The lead line inventory is still the priority even with the other work to be done, any help from the public is needed to complete this task.

Attended WHS Monthly meeting, which are held in my office on the 1st Wednesday of every month.

Sarah Farrar continues to come in frequently doing family research.

I continue filing and adding people to the Ancestry program, from the Cindy Needham collection. There is **still** a huge amount to go through.

Char Bivona continues to come in weekly both in my office and the Museum. WE STARTED WORKING ON MAINTENANCE AROUND THE SEWER PLANT. WE REMOVED ALL THE FALLEN TREES THAT WERE DAMAGED THROUGHOUT THE WINTER.

THE ULTRAVIOLET SYSTEM HAS BEEN INSTALLED AND RUNNING. A FEW BULBS AND QUARTZ SLEEVES HAD TO BE REPLACED WITH NEW ONES. WE HAD TO REGREASE AND ADD ANTICLEAN GEL TO THE UV SYSTEM.

DEC CALLED OVER DEC'S SEWER LINE COMING DOWN HUDSON ST. THEY ARE HAVING ISSUES WITH THEIR PUMP STATION AND WANTED TO KNOW THE INFORMATION ON PIPE SIZE AND LENGTH IN CASE THEY HAD TO REPLACE.
