They also participated in a meet in Saratoga Springs and finished 3rd overall competing against the largest schools in Section 2. It was the third straight Adirondack League and Section 2 Class D Championship.

Another milestone for the Team is they placed 3rd in the first ever New York State Dual Team Championships.

Also Coach Mark Trapasso was named Section 2 Division II Varsity Coach of the Year and Coach Scott McKenna was named Section 2 Division II JV Coach of the Year.
